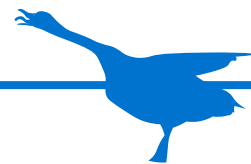


Not A Puzzle - solution

Take the opposite of each clue. The first set of numbers tells you the number of letters in the answer in reverse order. The following number [n] tells you to take the n-th letter from the back of the answer. Take all the letters from each answer and write it in reverse to get PASTEREADER. Take the opposite of this to get the answer COPYWRITER.
