Where???????? - Solution

Faculty: Engineering

Each word on the board can be combined with another word to form a compound word. For each group find one new word that, when combined with all three words in the group, forms three compound words. The new word should either be put before of all three words or be put after all three words (not a mix of before and after). Here is the list of the compound words.

| DAYdream | cross FIRE |
|--------------|---------------------|
| DAYlight | cease FIRE |
| DAYtime | camp FIRE |
| BODYboard | after MARKET |
| BODYguard | super MARKET |
| BODYbuilding | up MARKET |
| WHATsit | paper WORK |
| WHATnot | guess WORK |
| WHATever | patch WORK |

Form two new groups, each containing three words. The first group contains the words DAY, BODY and WHAT since all three of these words were added in front of the given words. The second group contains the words FIRE, MARKET and WORK since these words were all added after the given words. Then repeat the same idea and find two new words that can be added to form compound words.

| SOMEday | $\operatorname{fire}\mathbf{PLACE}$ |
|----------------------|-------------------------------------|
| SOMEbody | market PLACE |
| \mathbf{SOME} what | work PLACE |

Take the two words SOME and PLACE and combine to form the compound word, and answer, SOMEPLACE.
